





## Is the CHAMPION-AF Trial right for me?

The CHAMPION-AF clinical trial aims to generate evidence that may provide a first choice alternative option to blood thinners for patients with AFib, not caused by a heart valve problem, who would not be eligible to receive a WATCHMAN FLX™ Implant device with the current indication.
