2015 CPT Code Crosswalk for The S-ICD™ System (Subcutaneous Implantable Defibrillator)



The S-ICD™ System (Subcutaneous Implantable Defibrillator) procedures are reported in 2014 using Category III CPT Codes 0319T-0328T. The American Medical Association has published new Category I CPT codes for all S-ICD procedures effective January 1, 2015. S-ICD Category I CPT Code Relative Value Units (RVUs) will be published as part of the Medicare Physician Fee Schedule Final Rule in early November of 2014. The following table is a CPT Code 2014 to 2015 crosswalk.
