General Reimbursement & Coverage

What reimbursement resources are available for endobariatric procedures?

Boston Scientific provides coding and payment resources that include commonly used CPT®, ICD-10, and HCPCS codes, RVUs, and Medicare national average reimbursement rates across inpatient, outpatient, office, and ASC settings.

Are payer policies standardized across all insurers?

No. **Coverage policies, coding requirements, and site-of-service guidelines vary by payer** and individual benefit plan. Verification of coverage and authorization requirements prior to treatment is recommended.

Does Boston Scientific guarantee reimbursement or coverage?

Does ASMBS endorse endobariatric procedures?

The American Society for Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery (ASMBS) has published position statements recognizing procedures such as Endoscopic Sleeve Gastroplasty (ESG) and Transoral Outlet Reduction (TORe) as evidence-based endobariatric therapies when performed in appropriately selected patients by trained providers.

Procedures & Eligibility

Which procedures fall under endobariatrics? What solutions does Boston Scientific offer to support them?

Common endobariatric procedures include:

- Endoscopic Sleeve Gastroplasty (ESG)
- Transoral Outlet Reduction (TORe)
- Intra gastric balloon placement

Boston Scientific offers OverStitch™ endoscopic suturing for ESG and TORe procedures, as well as the ORBERA™ Intra gastric Balloon System for weight loss therapy.

Will insurance cover endobariatric procedures?

Coverage is **not guaranteed** and depends on the payer's medical policy, the patient's benefit plan, and individual clinical circumstances.

Who is typically eligible for endobariatric procedures?

Eligibility varies by procedure and individual patient factors, but generally includes adults with obesity seeking weight loss. See the IFU for each product for specific procedure requirements. All IFUs can be found at www.IFU-BSCI.com.

What happens if prior authorization is denied?

If prior authorization is denied, providers and patients may have the option to appeal the decision based on the payer's requirements and procedures.

Patient Access & Support

What is the Patient Access Support Program (PASP)?

PASP supports the patient's pathway to coverage through eligibility and benefit verification and prior authorization efforts, including available levels of appeal and external review when permitted by the payer.
